Dear Responsible Parties:

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH), in our 19 October 2017 directive letter, requested that you perform a soil, groundwater and soil gas investigation and submit an Additional Investigation Report no later than 19 January 2018. To date, the investigation has not been completed and an acceptable report has not been submitted. To address ACDEH concerns regarding potential vapor intrusion, please submit the report. Failure to submit the report places you in non-compliance status and may subject you to enforcement actions.

The ACDEH requires you complete the investigation and submit your findings in a written report within 30 days of the date of this letter and not later than 23 February 2018. Provide 72-hour written notification to robert.schultz@acgov.org prior to the start of field activities. Send us the reports described below according to the specified schedule.

Concurrent with your completion of the investigation requested in ACDEH's 19 October 2017 directive, the ACDEH requests a meeting between Chevron, the Oakland Veterinary Clinic, Mr. Rajan Gowarmy, and representatives for each party on 13 February 2018 at 1:00 PM, in ACDEH's conference room at 1131 Harbor Bay Parkway in Alameda, California. Discussion at the meeting will not affect this letter's request for additional investigation by Chevron, so please complete the investigation and reporting activities directed in ACDEH's 19 October 2017 letter as soon as possible, and not later than 23 February 2018. The meeting is intended to discuss: (1) progress by Chevron towards collecting and analyzing soil gas and groundwater samples for the full list of common VOCs specified by the DTSC; (2) the findings summarized in the 19 January 2018 Site Assessment Report prepared by Arcadis, including the histogram presented

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for sample SB-26-8 and buried debris observations; (3) the Focused Remedial Action Plan (RAP) and the service station expansion project; and (4) the pathway to cleanup and closure of this case.

TECHNICAL REPORT REQUEST

Please upload technical reports to the State Water Resources Control Board's GeoTracker website according to the following schedule and file-naming convention:

These reports are being requested pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 25296.10. 23 CCR Sections 2652 through 2654, and 2721 through 2728 outline the responsibilities of a responsible party in response to an unauthorized release from a petroleum UST system, and require your compliance with this request.
