On behalf of Chevron Environmental Management Company (Chevron), Stantec Consulting Services Inc. (Stantec) respectfully requests an extension to submit the Second Semi-Annual 2017 Groundwater Monitoring Report for former Chevron-branded service station 91723, which was located at 9757 San Leandro Street, Oakland, Alameda County, California (the Site). In a letter dated June 13, 2017, Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) requested the Second 2017 Semi-Annual Groundwater Monitoring Report be submitted on October 27, 2017.

The Second Semi-Annual 2017 groundwater monitoring event was conducted late in Third Quarter on September 18, 2017, and laboratory data has not been received. Therefore, Stantec requests a brief extension to submit the groundwater monitoring report to ACEH by November 17, 2017, to allow sufficient time to receive the laboratory data and prepare the report.
