**PROPOSED ADDENDUM TO CONTAINER FREIGHT SITE REMEDIAL  
DESIGN IMPLEMENTATION PLAN (RDIP), 1285 FIFTH STREET,  
CYPRESS RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT, OAKLAND**

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) received via facsimile Caltrans' revisions to the proposed amendment to the Container Freight Site RDIP. The revisions were made in response to comments contained in DTSC's September 15, 1997 letter to Caltrans. DTSC has reviewed the submittal and finds that all comments were addressed; therefore, the amended plan is approved. DTSC suggests that the final amended plan state that the proposed criteria to determine whether a temporary cap is needed should include whether concentrations are less than established background levels.
