Yes you are correct. Geotracker has been updated to reflect the change in approach that was discussed in the meeting yesterday. ACEH anticipates that work will incorporate requested scope of work changes and will also include additions to the scope of work that will fill LTCP data gaps as identified in the November 21, 2013 directive letter, and enable review under the LTCP. This includes additional bores in the older dispenser areas (secondary source removal), collection of shallow soil for site COCs in source areas, evaluation of the need for soil vapor along the northern property line, and etc. Should questions arise, please let me know.

Based on the discussion in our meeting of April 24, 2014, ACEH has extended the submittal date for the work plan addendum to August 1, 2014. As provided in the meeting, older as-built site plans have been located that indicate that former dispenser islands extended further to the south and the east than the current configuration. The older configuration may address several contaminant distribution data gaps at the site. CRA will install additional bores to investigate these areas in the pending investigation.
