As per my update status report, we started (January 17, 2011) the constructing of the new treatment compound and trenching and connecting the treatment compound to the Brighton Ave. intercept trench. The EBMUD discharge permit has finally been renewed, but until the treatment compound is completed and PG&E connects the upgraded power, we cannot start pumping. We have had a delay in our trenching/piping due to sewer leakage into our trench from 4003 Park Blvd. They had their sewer lateral examined and are replacing it today (February 2), once the leakage has been stopped and the biofouled utility sand that we placed into the trench prior to the leak has been removed we will continue the Brighton Ave connection. We also had a drilling rig on site to obtain the geotechnical samples for the production of the required grading permit, to perform the excavation later this summer. At that time I also acquired two soil samples for analysis of TPHg, BTEX and MtBE to evaluate where the soil concentrations are at this time. I will give you an update report once the treatment system is completed and ground water pumping has resumed with the soil analysis.

I anticipate completion of the current activates by next week, with pumping to start soon afterwards.
