I have uploaded the Tesoro-Livermore site 1Q10 Status Report to the FTP site. Attached are the tables from the report in excel form for your review. Included in the 1Q10 status report is a well abandonment scope of work. Due to the sound wall layout for the proposed remediation system equipment area, one of the footings for the wall is in conflict with former remediation well RW-4. Well RW-4 has not been in operation since 1997. We would like to abandon the well on Tuesday May 25<sup>th</sup> to facilitate the installation of the sound wall.
