
Dear Mr. Cullen,

ExxonMobil respectfully requests a 5-year review of the above referenced case.

This site has been delineated, remediated and the residual hydrocarbon impacts are attenuating. Concentrations of hydrocarbons and methyl tertiary butyl ether in wells indicate generally stable or decreasing trends and the remaining concentrations do not pose a significant threat to human health and to the environment. A Case Closure Request was submitted to the LOP, Alameda County Health Care Services Agency (ACHCSA), in June 2006. The ACHCSA subsequently requested a soil vapor survey and an additional offsite subsurface investigation, and a work plan for the requested work was submitted in October 2009.
