Comments: A 2,000-gallon <sup>diesel</sup> tank was removed from the site in Dec. 1988 and two soil samples were collected from beneath the tank. Analyses of these samples identified up to 6,400 ppm TPH as diesel and 3,700 ppm Oil and Grease. There are four wells on site, however, it is uncertain when these wells were installed (it may have been done in August 1989). In March 1990, analysis of groundwater samples collected from the on-site wells identified contamination only in Well R-3, which is located adjacent to the former OST location. 3.4 ppb benzene, 86 ppb xylene, and 267 ppm TPH as diesel was identified in these samples. In January 1992, consultants to RP submitted a Work Plan for Remediation by Excavation of Diesel-Impacted Soils.
