## Hi Kiersten,

Thanks for your note. As mentioned I had thought this covered already. I am in agreement that the sampling interval for wells MW-9 to MW-17 should be reduced significantly as the wells have been essentially nondetect for between approximately 2 to 2.5 years and are unlikely to change significantly. I believe bi-annual sampling (every other year) of the wells will be sufficient to monitor potential changes at the site; however, the wells and DTW should be measured at least once a year and otherwise maintained so they are in compliance with the DWR Well Standards (see Part III, Section 21, pg 28). The wells should also be sampled (and results obtained) prior to destruction to verify there have been no significant changes prior to the actual destruction. Hope this helps.

## Hi Mark,

To follow up on our phone conversation, CRA recommends discontinuing sampling intermediate and deep wells MW-9 through MW-17 because hydrocarbon concentrations have steadily decreased to below laboratory detection limits, and no hydrocarbons have been detected since 2008.
