Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) and California Regional Water Quality Control Board staff have reviewed the fuel leak case file and case closure summary for the above-referenced site and concur that no further action related to the underground storage tank fuel release is required at this time. Prior to issuance of a remedial action completion certificate, monitoring wells at the site must be properly destroyed, per California Water Code and all current record owners of fee title to the site must be notified by the primary or active responsible party of the proposed closure action.

ACEH requests that you address the following technical comments, perform the proposed work, and send us the technical reports requested below by the date identified. Upon receipt of the requested documents a remedial action completion certificate will be sent to the responsible party.

TECHNICAL COMMENTS

 Monitoring Well Destruction – ACEH requests that you contract with an appropriately registered environmental consultant (licensed Professional Geologist or Profession Engineer) and have them contact the Alameda County Public Works Agency at (510) 567-6791 to obtain the necessary well destruction permits, decommission the well, and electronically upload the well decommissioning report to ACEH's ftp server and the State Water Resources Control Board's GeoTracker website by the date identified below.

Upon our receipt of the report of well decommissioning, (which includes confirmation of investigation derived waste disposal) this office will issue you the remedial action completion certificate.
