Dear Hadjian & Simin Hooshang:

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) and California Regional Water Quality Control Board staff have reviewed the fuel leak case file and case closure summary for the above-referenced site and concur that no further action related to the underground storage tank fuel release is required at this time. Prior to issuance of a remedial action completion certificate, monitoring wells at the site must be properly destroyed, per California Water Code.

This is the second notice to destroy your groundwater monitoring wells at the site that you have received. The first request was made by letter on September 26, 2012 (**Copy attached**). To date the well destruction report has not been submitted. Failure to comply with this directive may result in your becoming ineligible to receive grant money from the state's Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund (Senate Bill 2004) to reimburse you for the cost of cleanup and will result in referral to the county's District Attorney's office.

ACEH is requesting that you contact Alameda County Public Works Agency at (510) 567-6791, obtain the necessary permits, decommission the wells, and electronically upload the monitoring well decommissioning report to ACEH's FTP server and the State Water Resources Control Board's GeoTracker website by **January 25, 2013**. Electronic reporting is described in detail below. Upon our receipt of the report of well decommissioning, (and confirmation of investigation derived waste disposal) this office will issue you the remedial action completion certificate.
