INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE EXPEDITED CLAIM ACCOUNT PROGRAM (ECAP): CLAIM NO. 16793 FOR SITE ADDRESS: 15101 FREEDOM AVENUE, SAN LEANDRO

The ECAP is a new program intended to reduce the time to reach case closure and the overall cost for site cleanup at underground storage tank (UST) sites. Senate Bill 445 (Statutes, 2014, chapter 547) requires the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) to create a pilot project including claims that meet certain criteria to explore ways to meet these goals. The ECAP Pilot Project is required to increase coordination regarding corrective action for these ECAP Pilot Project sites among the regulatory agency staff, claimants and their consultants, and UST Cleanup Fund (Fund) staff. We are soliciting Fund claimants who may have appropriate cases to participate in the Pilot Project.

This letter is to inform you that your UST case may meet selection criteria that the State Water Board will consider for adoption for cases to participate in the ECAP Pilot Project. Effective implementation of the ECAP Pilot Project will require the claimant and their consultant to work closely with regulatory agency staff and Fund staff as part of a Joint Execution Team (JET), to perform a number of tasks that will be documented in a Project Execution Plan (PEP) which will be developed for all corrective actions necessary for the UST case closure:

- Develop and agree on a Conceptual Site Model for the UST case.
- Determine and agree on the case closure criteria in the State Water Board's Low-Threat UST Case Closure Policy that have not yet been met for the UST case.
- Identify and agree on clearly defined corrective action tasks to be implemented in order to meet case closure criteria and identify the case closure criteria each action is intended to meet.
- Include in the PEP detailed cost estimates and schedules for corrective action tasks needed for the site to meet case closure criteria and be closed. PEP cost estimates will be used as a multi-year plan for Fund annual site budgets.

- Inform all members of the JET as soon as conditions change that may affect the PEP or any of its elements, including tasks, schedule, and cost.
