This email is a summary of our conversation yesterday. On Wednesday December 9, 2009, Ms. Alicia Falk of Stantec spoke with Mr. Paresh Khatri of the Alameda County Environmental Health Department (the County), the regulator for the Goodyear Castro Valley Site (3430 Casto Valley Boulevard, Castro Valley, CA), regarding the delay in the implementation of the approved corrective action plan (CAP). Mr. Khatri stated that is was unnecessary to conduct the semi-annual sampling event at the Site until the replacement well for MW-3 is installed.

Mr. Khatri requested submittal of a summary letter describing the results of the work completed to date and the revised scope of work for the CAP. A proposed deadline for the completion of the CAP and semi-annual sampling events should also be included in the summary letter.
