Dear Mr. Brown and Arthur R. and Mary A. Hansen Trust:

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) is reviewing the fuel case file for the above referenced site for potential case closure. Site investigation and groundwater monitoring from underground storage tank leaks have been performed at the subject property to which you are named as the primary or active responsible party. Pursuant to Section 25297.15 (a), ACEH, the local agency, shall not consider cleanup or site closure proposals from the primary or active responsible party, issue a closure letter, or make a determination that no further action is required with respect to a site upon which there was an unauthorized release of hazardous substances from an underground storage tank subject to this chapter unless all current record owners of fee title to the site of the proposed action have been notified of the proposed action by the primary or active responsible party. ACEH is required to notify the primary or active responsible party of their requirement to certify in writing to the local agency that the notification requirement in the above-mentioned regulation has been satisfied and to provide the local agency with a complete mailing list of all record fee title owners.

To satisfy the above-mentioned requirement, please complete the enclosed "List of Landowners Form," and mail it back to ACEH within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter. Also your comments must be considered prior to the proposed cleanup or closure. Please respond within 30 days from the date of this letter for your comments to be considered.

ACEH will review the case for possible closure under a commercial land use scenario with the following site management requirements:

"Case closure for the fuel leak site is granted for the current commercial land use only. If a change in land use to any residential or other conservative land use scenario occurs at this site, Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) must be notified as required by Government Code Section 65850.2.2. ACEH will re-evaluate the case upon receipt of approved development/construction plans. Excavation or construction activities in the areas of residual contamination require planning and implementation of appropriate health and safety procedures by the responsible party prior to and during excavation and construction activities. This site is to be entered into the City of Oakland Permit Tracking System due to the residual contamination on site."

In order to notify potentially affected members of the public of the potential fuel leak case closure, we request that you distribute the attached Notification of Potential Case Closure to the addresses shown on attached mailing list **no later than March 20, 2012**. The Notification of Potential Case Closure requests that landowners or residents submit any comments or questions to ACEH regarding potential case closure by April 24, 2012. Notifications to duplicate addresses may be omitted. Following distribution by U.S. Mail to the attached mailing list, please submit written verification of the date that the Notification of Potential Case Closure was distributed. ACEH will consider all comments from the public prior to potential case closure.



Summary - This fact sheet has been prepared to inform community members and other interested parties of potential case closure for a fuel leak case at the Shell-branded service station at 105 5th Street in Oakland, California (see attached map on back). Site investigation and cleanup activities have been completed and it does not appear that the fuel release presents a risk to human health for nearby residents or site workers. Site investigation activities, which were conducted at various times between 1999 and 2012, have defined the extent of petroleum hydrocarbons in soil, soil vapor, and groundwater beneath the site. Groundwater monitoring was conducted from July 1999 to July 2008 using seven groundwater monitoring wells at the site. The groundwater monitoring data indicate that the concentrations of petroleum hydrocarbons in groundwater have decreased since 1999 and that water quality is expected to be restored to water quality objectives through natural attenuation processes. During the most recent groundwater sampling event in July 2008, the maximum concentration of total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg) detected in groundwater beneath the site was 980 micrograms per liter (parts per billion). Between August 2009 and December 2011, soil vapor sampling was conducted at ten locations throughout and along the margins of the site. Elevated concentrations of petroleum hydrocarbons were detected in soil vapor samples collected from three locations within the interior portion of the site but were not detected at concentrations of concern along the margins of the service station or near the station kiosk. The residual contamination does not appear to pose a risk to nearby residents or site workers.

Background – The site is an active service station at the corner of 5th Street and Oak Street in Oakland, CA. A fuel release was discovered during an upgrade of the dispensers and piping system in November 1996. Soil and groundwater sampling activities have taken place at various times between 1999 and 2012. Periodic dual-phase vacuum extraction was conducted from April 2000 to March 2001 to remove petroleum hydrocarbons in the vapor and groundwater phases. Periodic groundwater extraction was conducted at the site from November 2001 to June 2006.

Next Step – The public is invited to review and comment on the potential closure of the fuel leak case.
