Per our phone discussion, please note that the B-12 designation resulted from an error on the Chain-of-Custody and did not refer to a 10<sup>th</sup> boring. The revised EDF submitted to Geotracker corrects the error and specifies results for only 9 borings (B-1 through B-9). The report (and lab report in the report) did not include the B-12 error; however, I did not catch the EDF error. My apologies.

Dear Mr. Atthowe,

On May 11, 2015, Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) denied the document entitled *Report of Soil and Groundwater Investigation* (GEO\_REPORT) submitted to the State Water Resources Control Board's (SWRCBs) GeoTracker website. The document was prepared by Gribi Associates (Gribi) and dated December 30, 2013. The reason ACEH gave for the denial was the associated laboratory analytical report, in electronic deliverable format (EDF), and map showing the boring locations (GEO\_MAP) had not been uploaded with the report.

On May 27, 2015, ACEH denied the May 15, 2015 submittal of the EDF associated with the GEO\_REPORT pending resolution of the number of borings advanced at the site. The GEO\_REPORT states that nine borings were advanced as part of the investigation; however, the EDF contained the analytical results for 10 borings. It is unclear to ACEH if nine or 10 borings were advanced for the GEO\_REPORT investigation as the analytical results of only nine borings are presented in Table 1, nine borings are depicted on the GEO\_REPORT Figure 3, and the GEO\_REPORT contains bore logs for nine borings.

On May 28, 2015, Gribi submitted a revised EDF containing the results of nine borings. Acceptance of the revised EDF submittal is pending, awaiting clarification of the analytical results for the 10<sup>th</sup> boring in the initial EDF submittal.

Please inform ACEH why the 10<sup>th</sup> boring, identified as boring B-12 in the EDF was installed and why analytical field data collected, and indicate whether or not it should be included in an amended GEO\_REPORT. Please provide your comments in an email (Attn.: Keith Nowell) to ACEH by **June 12, 2015**.
