Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) staff has reviewed the case file in conjunction with the State Water Resources Control Board's (SWRCBs) Low Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy (LTCP). Based on our review, the case does not appear to meet the LTCP Groundwater Specific criteria as the contaminant plume is not defined in the up gradient direction.

Therefore, ACDEH requests preparation and submittal of a work plan for further plume definition by the date specified below.
