Dear Responsible Parties:

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) staff has reviewed the case files including the document entitled *Soil and Groundwater Investigation Report (SWI)* dated August 21, 2017 and prepared by Gribi Associates (Gribi) for the subject site. The SWI was performed at the request of ACDEH in our letter dated June 5, 2017 which conditionally approved the May 22, 2017 work plan prepared by Gribi.

As part of our review, we have determined the case may meet the State Water Resources Control Board's (SWRCBs) Low Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy (LTCP). In order to make a determination of the closure, ACDEH requests a meeting to discuss the disposition of the case in light of the recent data. Prior to the meeting, ACDEH requests the case files for the site be updated with missing documentation as address in the technical comments below.

TECHNICAL COMMENTS

1. Electronic Submittal of Information –

- a. **GEO_MAP** – As part of our review of the documents recently submitted to the SWRCBs GeoTracker website, ACDEH was unable to review the GEO_MAP associated with the August 21, 2017 SWI. ACDEH request submittal of Figure 3 of the SWI as the associated GEO_MAP. Please submit the document by the date specified below.
- b. **Well Abandonment Report** – The case files on the ACDEH FTP site do not contain the document entitled *Well Abandonment Report* dated January 27, 2015 and prepared by Gribi. ACDEH request submittal of the document by the date specified below.
