Dear Ms. Evans:


In your letter dated January 17, 1991, you requested that Ultramar Inc. (Ultramar) submit a workplan outlining the steps which will be taken to further investigate the extent of the contaminant plume and actions to contain and mitigate the plume. The deadline given for the submission of this workplan was to be February 28, 1991. However, the consultant preparing the workplan informed me today that they would be unable to submit the work plan by the deadline. The consultant (Groundwater Technology, Inc.) believes the workplan will be completed by March 4, 1991. After Ultramar review the workplan will be forwarded to you. It is anticipated that you should receive it by March 8, 1991. I apologize for the delay.

In reference to Item 3 in your letter, a well survey has already been performed and is included in the Problem Assessment Report dated November 22, 1989 prepared by Du Pont Environmental Remediation Services. I am enclosing a copy for your files.
