## Hi Brian.

I did get your voice mail from July 25<sup>th</sup>, but I was between trips out of town so could not get back to you as quickly as I'd have liked. Regardless, I wanted to make sure you're aware the case was transferred to the RWQCB due to the lack of timely progress (see attached). I can still access the case on Geotracker and if you wanted to submit the work plan addendum to the ACEH ftp site I can cross check it against what was uploaded to Geotracker, and potentially approve acceptance (receipt) of the addendum. That would be about as far as I can go, but it would help the RWQCB move the site forward a smidge. Don't forget, ACEH would require the perjury statement for acceptance. The incomplete submittal (only to the State and not to the County) appears to be the principal reason it has been delayed. It's a good way to slow down progress; we've more than enough work to not be aware of every submittal on Geotracker. Regards,
