Jerry,

Per our conversation today, CRA has conducted a survey of nearby properties and found three former gasoline station sites from the 1920s to 1940s within 500' of the site, to go along with three nearby LUFT sites which were previously identified. Based on this information we will submit a survey report and work plan addendum proposing additional off site borings to help identify off site sources of TPH in groundwater detected during our initial offsite investigation. The work plan will also include responses to issues identified in ACEH's 8/12/09 letter. We anticipate submitting the survey report/work plan by 11/13/09. As I noted in our conversation today, we are still working on an access agreement with the City of Oakland for the Oakland Sr. Center property and have been told by the City of Oakland that they will not issue any street encroachment permits during the holiday shopping season (through 1/2/10).
