MEMO to file:

I received a message from and returned a call to Jim Brownell (Delta) regarding the status of MW-1. He said it was "inaccessible" because construction debris had obscured its location, and was filled partially by "po gravel." I reminded him that in April 1997 this well was also reported as damaged during construction at the site, and that it and MW-4 (also damaged) were to be rehabilitated. MW-4 was eventually destroyed under permit with several others. I also reminded him that it appeared MW-1 was fixed shortly thereafter because it was reportedly sampled/monitored 5/97. This the last time MW-1 was sampled. The 3rd qtr report indicates MW-1 was inaccessible due to debris/rubble. The 4th qtr report simply states it was "inaccessible."

Mr. Brownell now indicates the well is damaged and is substantially filled with gravel (as indicated above). He also said a "case closure" request is forth coming. I informed that it did not set well with me that this well has been out of commission for essentially a year w/o the problem being rectified, and that it was simply referred to as "inaccessible" all these months, which, to me, indicated a temporary condition.

I told him that I needed new data before considering the case closure request.
