Dear Mr. Chan:

This letter responds to your letter of August 6, 2001, regarding an evaluation of the above-referenced site for closure. To comply with your request for additional information, Brunsing Associates, Inc. (BAI) proposes to prepare a document which includes a summary table of all soil and groundwater analytical data with a corresponding sample location map, an estimate of removal efficiency of the vapor extraction system that was used at the site, and a risk assessment that will include research into possible receptors in the area.

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Prior to preparing this document BAI proposes to collect and analyze groundwater samples from monitoring wells MW-2 and MW-3, and vapor recovery wells VRW-2, VRW-4 and VRW-6, if feasible. This sampling event is intended to provide current data on residual hydrocarbon levels in groundwater in these wells. Vapor recovery wells VRW-2 and VRW-4 were chosen for sampling because these wells had the highest concentrations of TPH as gasoline in groundwater when the wells were sampled prior to initiating vapor extraction. Vapor recovery well VRW-6 was selected for sampling because of the high concentration of TPH as gasoline (3,800 mg/kg) reported for the soil sample collected from the boring drilled for installation of this well.

We will proceed with sampling of the indicated wells upon receiving your concurrence to proceed and receiving cost pre-approval from the Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund.
