

Note to File RO614/RO788

The site was a Fisher Body Plant of Oakland Chevrolet manufacturing plant and parking lot from 1920 to 1960. The plant was located near the triangle section of the site at Foothill Blvd. and 73rd Avenue. The Goodyear is the Eastmont Auto store located southwest of the former Mervyn's (Current Oakland Police station).

On May 8, 1990, Thomas Peacock sent a letter to Eastmont Mall Associates requesting a tank closure work plan- number of tanks not provided for the site located at 7250 Bancroft Avenue, Oakland, CA. No additional directive letters are present in the file for RO614. Duplicate letters from RO788 are present in the file but these are listed as the One Eastmont Mall address not 7250 Bancroft Avenue.

One 550-gallon waste-oil UST was subsequently removed from Eastmont Auto on October 23/1995 at the address of One Eastmont Mall. A new case was opened for this tank at that time (RO788) and the case was closed under RO788 at One Eastmont Mall. Oakland Fire department only has the information from this one 500-gallon waste-oil UST removal. There is no additional tank removal for this site or the 7250 Bancroft Avenue address.

RO614 is a duplicate of closed case RO788. Files for RO614 were consolidated into RO788.
