Dear Owner/Operator:

According to our records your facility referenced above has not received a five-year permit to operate UST's. In order to obtain a permit you must complete the following items marked below and return them within 30 DAYS. The necessary forms are enclosed. You may complete a "Consolidated Underground Tank Management Plan" which will assist you in preparing a monitoring plan, site plot plan and spill response plan for your tank(s). If supplemental information or forms are required, please submit it to this office with the completed questionnaire and application forms:

- ___ 1. An accurate and complete plot plan.
- ___ 2. A written spill response plan. (enclosed)
- ___ 3. A written tank monitoring plan. (enclosed)
- ___ 4. Results of precision tank test(s), (initial and annual).
- ___ 5. Results of precision pipeline leak detector tests (initial and annual).
- ___ 6. Complete UST PERMIT FORM A-one per facility. (enclosed)
- ___ 7. Complete UST PERMIT FORM B-one per tank. (enclosed)
- ___ 8. Complete UST PERMIT FORM C-one per tank if information is available. (enclosed)
- ___ 9. Letter stating how the tank is to be maintained during one year closure.

Be advised that Title 23 of the California Code of Regulation prohibits the operation of "ANY" UST without a permit. If our records are in error, you must contact this office immediately TO AVOID POSSIBLE ENFORCEMENT ACTION. Please feel free to contact this office at (510) 271-4320; to answer any questions which may arise in completing the mandatory five-year permit process. Be prepared to provide your zip code to speak with the Hazmat Specialist handling your case.

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Ms. Berger:

On June 30, 1988, an inspection of hazardous waste compliance was conducted of your facility by this department. The following violations of the California Administrative Code, Title 22, Division 4, Chapter 30, were discovered:

1. On site disposal of hazardous waste which is a violation of 25189.5 of the Health and Safety Code. This violation occurred in the following areas:
 - a. Drain from a caustic hot tank in the GSA Paint Shop, which emptied into the sanitary sewer.
 - b. Drain from the waterfall for the paint spray booth in the GSA Paint Shop, which also emptied into the sanitary sewer.
2. Hazardous waste labels are not present from the date accumulation begins as required by 66508. This violation occurred for the waste paint/dirty thinner storage in the GSA Paint Shop.
3. Waste is not identified as hazardous waste as required by 66471.

In accordance with 66328, submit a Plan of Correction to this Department, within 14 days, stating the actions to be taken and the expected dates of completion to correct the above violations.

Your attention is directed to Sections 25183, 25189, and 25191 of the California Hazardous Waste Control Law, which provides for civil and criminal penalties of up to \$25,000 per day, per violation, for violations of the California Hazardous Waste Control Law and regulations.
