- 10/28/96 Gary Pislake, Hydro Envrn, (510) 521-2684
Mr. Pislake will submit a proposal to Mr. Barnhill ~~they~~ next week. Discussed site. Will notify me if Hydro Environmental is retained by Mr. Barnhill.
- 11/8/96 Spoke to Gary Pislake. He inquired as to whether it would be okay to place temporary sampling points in lieu of permanent wells. I stated that if they did find contaminant concentrations of concern from temporary locations, that they would have to install ^{at least one} permanent well.
- 11/25/96 Spoke to Gary Pislake re workplan. Need info on depths of Possey tube and depth of storm drain trench prior to approving workplan. Also, need to consider possibility of doing elevation contours for temporary sample points.
- 11/10/97 Gary Pislake, 510-521-2684, called to update County on implementation of workplan. Zone 7 has approved the proposed well installations, however, they are still waiting for Cal Trans to grant them access on to its right-of-way for Possey tube.
- 11/21/97 Gary Pislake called to say that he has moved the proposed southeastern geoprobe location ~4 feet west to get outside of the Cal Trans right-of-way instead of holding up the project by having to wait for Cal Trans to grant access. He said he would fax me copy of new location map + would schedule work for late this week or early next wk.
- 1/22/97 Gary Pislake called to say that geoprobe field work would commence on ^{the} Jan 30th.
- 3/27/97 Called Gary Pislake + inquired about the screen intervals of the geoprobes. The screened intervals were from about 3-3 1/2' to 8-8 1/2' bgs & w/ the water table being at ~4' bgs.

discovered that tank pit is right above the Webster
Tube, so there will be some problems w/ investigations.

of Webster Tube & tentative w.p. for my review
before setting up a meeting to discuss options.
