
RE: **Case Closure Regarding Underground Storage Tanks and

Dear Mr. Ditto,

The Alameda County Department of Environmental Health's (ACHD) Local Oversight Program and Site Mitigation staff have submitted letters which recommend the closure for your site involving two 10,000 gallon Underground Storage Tanks and also non-UST related, heavy chain hydrocarbon impacted soils. After discussions with County staff and review of the file for your site Regional Board staff concur with this recommendation. Therefore based on the available information for the above site, it appears that further investigation and cleanup of petroleum hydrocarbons are not necessary. Further work could be required if conditions change or a water quality threat is discovered at the site.
