This office and the San Francisco RWQCB have reviewed the case closure summary for the above referenced site and concur that no further action related to the underground tank release is required at this time. Before a remedial action completion letter is sent, the on-site and off-site monitoring wells and the dual vacuum extraction wells (C-1 through C-16) should be decommissioned, if they will no longer be monitored or used. Please notify this office upon completion of well destruction so a closure letter can be issued.
