On behalf of Interstate Brands Corporation, URS Greiner Woodward-Clyde (URSGWC) is pleased to present this Addendum to the proposed work plan for soil and groundwater sampling and analysis at the former IBC Facility at 46th Street in Emeryville, California. As requested in your letter, dated July 15, 1999, the sampling and analysis will be modified to include:

- 1- Total petroleum hydrocarbons as kerosene will be included as a target analyte in soil and groundwater samples in addition to TPH diesel, benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, xylenes and MTBE.
- 2- A minimum of one soil sample will be collected from the downgradient borings at the soil/groundwater interface and will be analyzed for the target compounds listed above.

We will notify the Alameda County office at least 72 hours prior to performing the field investigation activities.
