I spoke to Bruce Clark of IT Corporation today. He said he wanted to back fill the UST excavation, even though they had not gotten any results back from samples collected from native material below the USTs. IT mobil lab was on site to run analyses.

I ~~am~~ told Mr. Clark that I did not approve of back filling until results are known. He said that Southland Corp. would pursue soil "remediation" at some later time if need be. I emphasized that it is better, ^{and} more cost and environmentally effective to excavate now, while the pit is open. Further, if "hazardous waste" levels of HCs are detected, excavation would be prudent, rather than having to apply for Waste Discharge Requirements through RWQCB.
