

Ladies and Gentlemen:

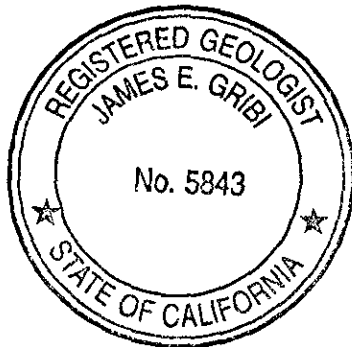
In accordance the December 7, 1998 letter from your office, the three groundwater monitoring wells (MW-1, MW-2, and MW-3) at the City of Livermore Water Reclamation Plant underground storage tank (UST) site located at 101 Jack London Boulevard have been properly decommissioned. The three wells were pressure grouted by Kvilhaug Well Drilling on Wednesday, February 17, 1999, in accordance with the Alameda County Zone 7 Water Agency permit (Permit No. 99044).
