

Phone Log (15526 Desperian Blvd)

- 6/30/95 Mark Miller w/ Chevron called to say he cannot make the 7/10/95 deadline. The consultant has committed by July 24th.
- 7/7/95 Argy Leyton w/ Hettler Ryan called to say they plan to submit the w/P by 7/21/95 → (510) 551-7555. Hettler performed the present well abandonment.
- 7/18/95 Mark Miller called to discuss utility line survey along Sparnore St + Desperian Blvd. He indicated that the sewer lines along both streets are generally above seasonal gw levels + that he does not believe they are a conduit for plume migration. He questioned the necessity to ~~submit~~ re-locate a new well to replace MW2 — I told him it was necessary to serve as a "guard" well + MW5 would serve as a boundary well. He indicated the w/P would be submitted by 7/24/95.
- 1/2/96 Called + left message for Tammy Hodge, Chevron, 842-9449 inquiring about the status of the most recently due semi-annual monitoring report.
- 4/16/97 left message for Phil Briggs inquiring why Well 6 went dry in this last monitoring event + suggested that they may need to re-develop this well.
- 4/17/97 Mr. Briggs called back + said he would have Well 6 redeveloped.

4/27/94 Allison Watts called from Uwin and stated that they would want to destroy the wells, that are to be resealed, til this fall, since construction won't begin until fall.

8/11/94 Mark Miller, Chevron

Called in response to July 21st 94 letter. He stated that there have been modifications to the construction plans & Chevron is keeping wells active until further information is provided detailing final construction. Only monitoring is on schedule now. Mr. Miller will notify County when they intend to destroy wells & reseat.

2/23/94 Spoke to Alan Gordon, realtor for Oil Changes Business, (415) 668-2320. I explained that I received Mr. Miller's proposal to abandon Wells MW-2, 3, + 4 in conjunction w/ proposed building location. I requested that he submit info on depth of building & whether or not this building could be proposed further to the south to prevent destruction of pertinent Well MW-2. Also explained that Well MW-2 + MW-3 will most likely have to be replaced, & that there is the possibility that Well MW-2 will have to be relocated in the northern landscape area or w/in storage area of proposed building.

~~3/1/94~~ 2/28/94 Mark Miller called & left message stating that gravel identified from Well Log MW-3 is the result of backfill, & he stated that Well MW-6, in his opinion, would adequately represent the downgradient extent of plume.

3/1/94 Spoke to Mark Miller & reiterated why it is required to relocate both Wells MW-2 and MW-3. I stated, upon his request of annual sampling for MW-1, that it would be okay to switch MW-1 to ^{semi-}annual sampling, since so many quarters of ND.

4/14/94 Spoke to Mark Miller about the submittal of a timeline by May 7 '94. Also, about the potential for the proposed location of the building to change.

12/2/93 Keep an eye on sudden NO levels in MW 6.

12/30/93 Alan Gordon, Real Estate Agent for potential buyer, ⁴¹⁵⁻⁶⁶⁸⁻²³²⁰

Mr. Gordon stated that the prospective buyer wishes to start an oil changing business on property so that the current monitoring wells may need to be relocated. I said that he + Mark Melter must submit proposals as to where to place the new wells + whether any excavation will be conducted in areas of contaminated soil.

2/23/94 In response to Mark Melter's proposal to abandon Wells MW-2, 3, + 4 due to construction, I checked for utility lines along Sycamore St. to check the adequacy of monitoring Well 5 in place of Well 2. I called ~~the San Mateo~~ at 870-5400, San Lorenzo Public Works, to find out about sewer lines. There are sewer lines running down the center of Sycamore St., trenched in granular material, from ~8' bgs to 10' bgs. The trench is 18" wide and 2' tall. According to Don Baker, PGE (784-3227), there is a gas main running along the north side of Sycamore at ~24" to 36" bgs, at a height of ~36". He stated that they could be deeper due to grading. He stated that traffic signal utilities run along Sycamore at an unknown depth. Spoke to ~~EBMWS~~ EBMWS, ~~7-1008~~ + discovered water lines run along Sycamore at a minimum of 4' bgs, w/ width of ~2'. Lines are traditionally backfilled w/ native soil.

In response to a letter written by Dr. Bearint to the County, dated Nov 22, '92, Ms. Stein called to update herself on the situation between Dr. Bearint and Chevron.

Dr. Bearint stated that Chevron had a 15 yr. lease on the property when he bought it. When the lease terminated, Chevron had the option, in the contract, of continuing to a 5-yr. lease. They did so. Now that their 5-yr. lease is up, they do not wish to pay the rent any longer, even though, according to Dr. Bearint, Chevron has made the property undesirable to potential buyers and lessees because of the contamination.


