MEETING October 29, 1993

Attending:

Dan Kirk, Shell Oil Company Scott McLeod, Weiss Associates Juliet Shin, Alameda County Health Dept.

The meeting was held in response to the October 7, 1993 letter. Mr. Kirk wanted some clarification of the letter. I explained that I wanted to know what his intentions were for the site. Well MW-2 is consistently showing elevated levels of contaminants, and I feel that the extent of the plume has not yet been defined in the direction of Webster St. Mr. Kirk stated that he wanted to avoid placing any more wells in city streets, because of all the hastle with encroachment permits and utility lines. I stated that they must either look into remediation systems for the contamination, or completely characterize the extent of the ground water contaminant plume observed in MW-2 by installin another well, and conduct continued monitoring to determine whether this plume is migrating (i.e., "Alternate Points of Compliance"). I requested that they write a letter explaining the remediation systems they considering, and submit a rough schedule as to when they will begin assessing the feasibility of the remedial options and come to a decision as to what will be done at the site.
