Subsurface Consultants presented info, including chromatograph info, to indicate that the elevated levels of hydrocarbons identified in Well MW-5 is attributable to the former hydraulic hoists identified immediately east of the Well MW-5. We discussed

BTEX → The possibility of closing the site after an additional investigation phase, where the extent of the hydraulic hoist contamination is delineated, analysis is conducted for PNAs (benzo(a)pyrene and naphthalene), TDS, and chromatograph comparisons are conducted. Subsurface will then take a RBCA Tier 1 approach to assure that concentrations are not a threat to human health or and that no chance of oil impacting surface water. Subsurface also stated that they believed that the observed diesel concentrations was a regional problem based on their investigations on a neighboring site.

Subsurface will submit a work plan after the County checks w/ how Casias to see whether it is okay to close whole site, including hoists, under LOP.
