We were informed contamination was discovered on-site that extended out to Pacific Ave and Webster St. Approx. 3,000 cu. ft. of soil has been excavated out of the ground that is impacted with gas, diesel and waste oil. Larry informed them for safety purposes, the excavation can be back-filled with lean fill after soil samples are taken at a minimum of 200 sq. ft. The south end of the excavation is to be left open in the event the confirmatory samples on that wall is still impacted. The other walls are to the property line, or is N.D. (10/2)

Randy Stone of ENSCO will submit a complete report after he gets all the data in, but will submit a letter to me tomorrow requesting approval to backfill in the excavation. He will identify in the letter how he plans to backfill, and he has sampled every 200 cu ft. of soil. I also informed them before they bio-remediate, they have to determine whether the soil is hazardous. If it is hazardous, they have to get a permit or variance from DHS.

I also indicated they have to install a minimum of one monitoring well down-gradient, and it is also recommended one be also install up-gradient. Mr. Rigter and Cary told Mr. Larkin separately it would be best to install three wells for a more complete investigation for later use in their possible litigation.
