Alisto Engineering Group is pleased to submit this cost proposal to perform site investigation activities at former BP Site No. 11120, 6400 Dublin Boulevard, Dublin, California to comply with the requirements of the Alameda County Health Care Services Agency (ACHCSA).

SCOPE OF WORK

Four groundwater monitoring wells will be installed at the locations shown on the attached site plan. The proposed groundwater monitoring wells will be constructed of 2-inch-diameter casing to total depths of approximately 20 feet, with screened intervals from approximately 5 feet below grade to the bottom of the boring. The scope of work for site investigation includes the following tasks:

- Obtain a well installation permit from the Alameda County Department of Public Works and submit a work plan for well installation and sampling to the ACHCSA.
- Install four groundwater monitoring wells onsite at the locations shown on the attached site plan.
- Develop the proposed groundwater monitoring wells a minimum of 72 hours after completion.
- Survey the location and elevation of the proposed monitoring wells in accordance with State requirements for electronic data transfer.
- Collect groundwater samples from the four monitoring wells for analysis of constituents of concern by the BP Oil designated laboratory.
- Transport and dispose of investigative-derived wastes.

- Prepare a report to include description of field procedures, boring logs, tables, graphical interpretation of groundwater gradient and chemical concentrations, and results and findings of the assessment activities.

Soil samples collected during installation of the wells will be collected at 5-foot intervals for stratigraphic assessment, field screening, and laboratory analysis.

ESTIMATED BUDGET

The estimated budget for the proposed scope of work is \$15,379. A breakdown of the estimated budget for the proposed scope of work is presented in detail in the attached table. This budget will not be exceeded without prior authorization from BP Oil Company.

We will begin work on receipt of your authorization and a work order release. Please call if you have questions or need additional information.

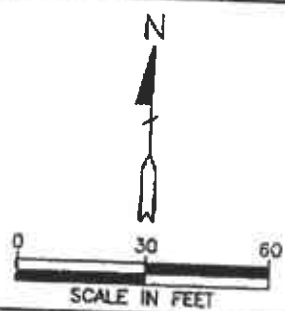
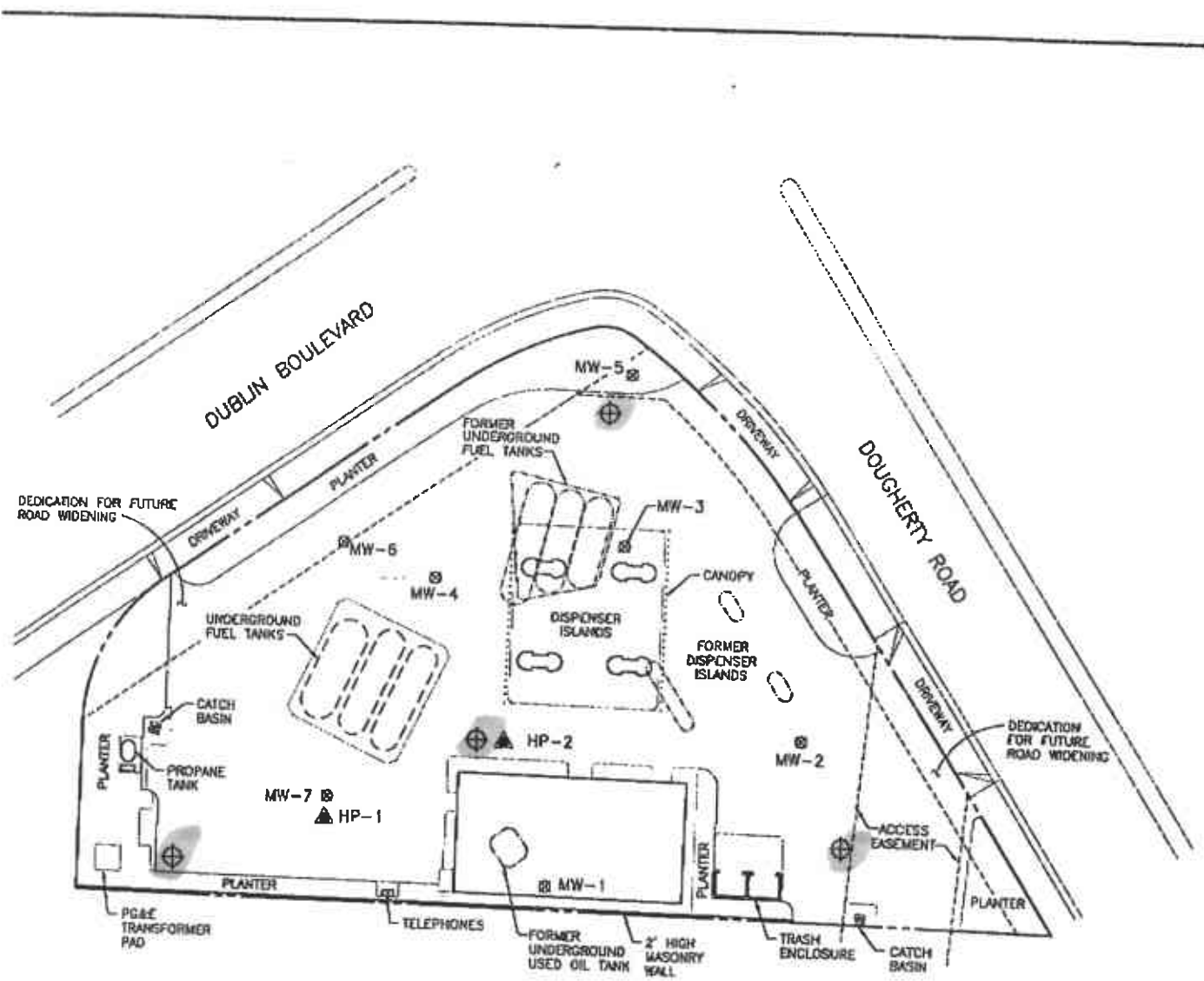
