Dear Mr. Detterman,

On behalf of Chevron Environmental Management Company (Chevron), Stantec Consulting Services Inc. (Stantec) respectfully requests an extension to submit the Site Investigation Report for former Chevron-branded service station 92029, which was located at 890 MacArthur Boulevard, Oakland, Alameda County, California (the Site). In a letter dated July 9, 2014, Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) requested a Site Investigation Report due on September 12, 2014. In an email dated August 22, 2014, the ACEH approved an extension for the due date for this report to November 14, 2014 due to delays associated with Oakland permitting. In an email dated November 7, 2014, the ACEH approved a second extension for the due date for this report to March 13, 2015, again due to delays associated with Oakland permitting. Following our meeting on April 22, 2015, an additional extension was granted to June 29, 2015, to allow time for Stantec to obtain additional Site Data requested by ACEH to include in the pending assessment report.

One of the pieces of information requested was off-site building construction details. Stantec worked with the City of Oakland to determine whether building plans are on file for the target properties. The City did a preliminary file search based on the target property addresses provided by Stantec, and they confirmed that building plans for the target properties are not on file. Therefore, Stantec is preparing a hard copy survey that will be sent to the individual target properties requesting the desired information. To allow sufficient time for residents to complete and return the surveys, and for Stantec evaluate the data and submit the Site Investigation Report, we respectfully requests that an extension be granted for the Site Investigation Report to be submitted to ACEH by August 31, 2015. If property tenants or owners are unresponsive, additional time may be needed to follow up with them. Stantec will keep ACEH updated should additional delays occur.
