

TL BUSH SAFETY PROGRAM

1.0 MANAGEMENT

1. All department managers shall maintain an accident prevention program. The program shall provide that capable, responsible persons shall make regular inspections of all excavations, forms, stairs, ladders, structures, machinery, and equipment at frequent intervals.
2. The department manager shall take immediate action to correct any hazards under his control.
3. Monthly (or more frequent) meetings of all foremen shall be held under the direction of management for a discussion of safety problems.
4. Supervisors shall conduct "tailgate" or "toolbox" safety meetings with their crews at the beginning of each new project and every 10 working days thereafter.
5. Joint labor/management cooperation and frequent jobsite inspections shall be performed to identify and correct unsafe work conditions or practices.

2.3 SUPERVISION

1. All work in an excavation will be supervised by a qualified person.
2. No person will be allowed to enter the excavation until a qualified person has determined that no hazard exists from moving ground. Under no circumstances will personnel be permitted to enter an excavation deeper than 5 feet. Proper shoring must be provided and OSHA approval received before personnel are permitted to enter excavation greater than 5 feet deep.
3. Supervisor shall carefully plan each job prior to beginning field operations. Consideration will be given to probable hazards in the operation related to methods, processes, practices, job site, etc. Workers will be trained to do their jobs properly and safely; supervisors shall pay special attention to training new workers.
4. In accordance with Construction Safety Order 1511, supervisors will make a thorough survey of the site conditions to determine so far as practicable, the predictable hazards to employees and the kind and extent of safeguards necessary to prosecute the work in a safe manner.
5. Supervisors will immediately report all serious job-related, or suspected job-related, injuries and deaths to the Division of Occupational Safety and Health.

3.0 SAFETY

1. All employees will be given instructions regarding the hazards and safety precautions applicable to the type of work in question and directed to read the code of safe practices.
2. Only those employees qualified by training or experience shall be permitted to operate equipment and machinery.
3. Where employees may be subject to hazardous materials or substances, they shall be instructed in the recognition of the hazard, in the procedures for protecting themselves, and in the first aid procedure in the event of injury.
4. Every employee will be provided with the necessary safety equipment required for that project, boots, gloves, hard-hats, etc.
5. No employee shall be required or knowingly permitted to work in an unsafe place, unless for the purpose of making it safe and then only after proper precautions have been taken to protect him while he is doing such work.

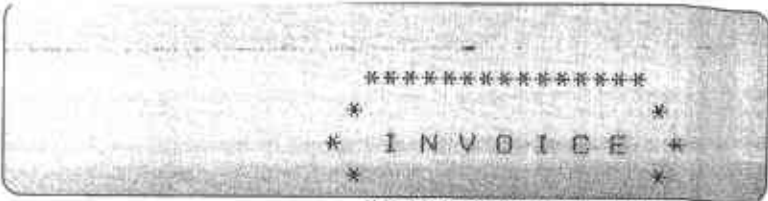

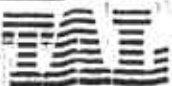
