Mark - based on field results of the vapor extraction field testing and follow-up discussion with Dilan Roe, we request an extension of 45 days to develop appropriate alternatives for mitigation of subsurface vapors. In the interim period, Geosyntec will be developing short-term options for reducing concentrations of VOCs in indoor air while the long-term mitigation program is being designed and funded.
