
The purpose of this letter is to document our telephone conversation of July 10, 2001. After reviewing the Alameda County Health Care Services Agency (ACHCSA) workplan approval letter dated July 2, 2001, and visiting the site to mark for Underground Service Alert, Blymyer Engineers, Inc. believes it is appropriate to relocate the proposed location of bore B-8 to the location of the former sump (Figure 2). The intent of bores B-7 and B-8 is to obtain worst-case contaminant concentrations. The location of the sump is reasonably a worst-case location, and the relocation of bore B-8 will investigate the sump. The distance between the two proposed locations for bore B-8 is approximately 15 feet, a relatively small distance.

As you suggested in your conversation with Mr. Robert Mintz, a shallow soil sample will be collected from the former location of bore B-8. The sample will be collected at a depth of 2.0 to 2.5 feet below surface grade. Additionally, a sample will be collected from bore B-7 at a similar depth. The samples will be analyzed for the five LUFT metals in an attempt to determine the depth of metal impact at the site.
