Due to further unexpected delays in obtaining a site access agreement from the current property owners to conduct the subsurface investigation at the former Grand Auto (current O'Reilly Auto) at 4240 International Blvd. in Oakland (ACEH case # RO0002483 and Geotracker Global ID # T06019705075), we were unable to perform the investigation field work activities until last Tuesday and Wednesday, January 4 and 5, 2012. In your e-mail of October 19, 2011, you had approved our previous request to extend the subsurface investigation report submittal deadline to January 23, 2012.

Since we do not expect the analytical results until late this week, and have a very heavy project workload, it is problematic whether we will be able to prepare and submit the subsurface investigation report by the January 23, 2012 deadline. We request an additional extension of the report submittal deadline to February 28, 2012.
