Mr. Weiss,
Thank you for your email; it should help with communications.

The Notice to Comply that was sent on July 24th is simply a request to claim the site in Geotracker, and as you note there are no reports to upload since the July 2005 date. The request to claim it remains a valid request; however, the lack of work since July 2005 definitely will make the process pretty quick.

To claim the site in Geotracker you can go directly to: http://www.swrcb.ca.gov/ust/electronic_submittal/index.shtml. Once there you can open the "Beginner's Guide" under "Getting Started"; however, it's probably better to just call the toll free number in the upper right corner and the Help Desk can walk you through the process. I understand it's a form that is printed and then faxed, but since I've not claimed a site, I don't fully know how it's done; so the Help Desk is likely your best bet. If you could send some sort of confirmation, it would be appreciated. I've seen email from Geotracker that documents a site is claimed, and I've seen a print out of sites associated with a party.

You should also be aware that the county can't remove the site from the state's database; it's a right we are not granted.

Also it would be helpful to receive updates on the contact information form. Emails help move the process along so that's an option as noted in the form.
