Dear Mr. Hill:

This is a notice of an enforcement referral for the subject site. Site Responsible Parties are non-responsive to Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) requests and are recalcitrant. The site has accumulated a series of enforcement letters from ACEH. As a consequence, ACEH is referring this site to the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board for enforcement actions.

## Site Background

The site contained an auto repair facility and a dry cleaner. Groundwater concentrations of up to 140,000 micrograms per liter ( $\mu$ g/L) total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg), 380  $\mu$ g/L total petroleum hydrocarbons as diesel (TPHd), 810  $\mu$ g/L benzene, 550  $\mu$ g/L cis-dichloroethene (c-1,2-DCE), and 60  $\mu$ g/L vinyl chloride (VC). The lateral and vertical extent of soil and groundwater contamination is undefined and appears to extend off site. The vapor intrusion pathway has not been evaluated.

A soil and groundwater investigation (SWI) work plan addendum requested on April 19, 2005 was not submitted. An SWI, due July 7, 2006, was also not submitted. ACEH issued a letter on June 7, 2006 requesting report submittal and claiming the site in GeoTracker and again in and July 2008 requesting the site be claimed by August 15, 2008. Notices to Comply and a Notice of Violation were issued on July 27, 2009, September 10, 2010 and on February 25, 2011 for non-submittal of reports and non-compliance with Geotracker regulations. There has been no response.
