WORK PERFORMED THIS QUARTER (First Quarter 2007):

1. Prepared and submitted the Fourth Quarter 2006 Status Report.

2. Investigated acceptability by Oakland Unified School District to drilling in open space of Oakland High School, north of and in lieu of drilling within Park Boulevard.

3. Met onsite with direct-push drilling company representative to discuss logistics of drilling (e.g., likely weekend work due to student and vehicular traffic, traffic control plan requirements, ramps to access base of hillside, etc.).

WORK PROPOSED FOR NEXT QUARTER (Second Quarter 2007):

- 1. Prepared and submitted this First Quarter 2007 Status Report (contained herein).
- 2. Secure access authorization from Oakland Unified School District attorney for drilling in open space of Oakland High School.
- 3. Schedule and execute work plan for offsite investigation.
- 4. Prepare Offsite Soil & Ground-Water Investigation Report, pending results availability.

DISCUSSION:

No environmental work has been performed for this site since early 2005. In a letter dated 16 October 2006, ACEH authorized BP to implement the Work Plan Addendum for Offisite Investigation. submitted by URS on 5 April 2005. Due to encroachment issues with City of Oakland and proximity to 16-inch diameter high-pressure gas main and other underground utilities, BAI and Stratus investigated the potential acceptability of the Oakland Unified School District to drilling within open space at Oakland High School immediately north of the previously-approved Hydropunch boring locations. These borings would be advanced into the base of a small hillside over and behind a short concrete block retaining wall. A photograph of the proposed boring locations is provided as an attachment. A Proposed Hydropunch Boring Locations plan is provided as Drawing 1.
