The subject site is being regulated under the Site Cleanup Program (SCP) and is in the queue for closure review. ACEH is currently prioritizing Leaking Underground Fuel Tank (LUFT) sites due to SWRCB mandates associated with implementation of the Low Threat Closure Policy. ACEH has a number of very active SCP cases at this time and is fitting them into the closure review queue as time allows. We anticipate that after August 17<sup>th</sup>, 2013, the LUFT case load will become more manageable. We look forward to actively moving this case along a path to closure.
