Dear Mr. Hill:

This is a notice of an enforcement referral for the subject site. Site Responsible Parties are non-responsive to Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) requests and are recalcitrant. The site has accumulated a series of Notice of Violations from ACEH. As a consequence, ACEH is referring this site to the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board for enforcement actions.

## **Site Background**

Seven USTs, including storage for gasoline and waste oil, were removed in April 1987. Soil and groundwater investigations (SWI) revealed concentrations including up to 1,700 milligrams per kilogram (mg/kg) total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH) as gasoline (g), 140  $\mu$ g/L TPH as diesel (d), 600 mg/kg TPH as motor oil (mo), and 51,000  $\mu$ g/L benzene in soil and up to 2,100,000 micrograms per liter ( $\mu$ g/L) TPHg, 7,700  $\mu$ g/L TPHd, 7,600  $\mu$ g/L TPHmo, and 51,000  $\mu$ g/L benzene in groundwater. Detectable levels of ethyl tertiary butyl ether (MtBE) were reported at the site up to 72  $\mu$ g/L. The lateral and vertical extent of contamination is undefined and appears to extend off site.

A soil and groundwater investigation (SWI) to include a site conceptual model (SCM) was to be submitted on October 20, 2008 with a subsequent request providing an April 20, 2009 submittal date. The report was not submitted. No further reports documenting work have been received. ACEH requested the site be claimed in GeoTracker by August 15, 2008 and issued Notices of Violation on July 28, 2009 and February 25, 2011 for non-compliance with GeoTracker regulations. There has been no response.
