This message is to rescind the recommendation case closure presented in Trinity's June 30, 2016 *2016 Sub-Slab Vapor Depressurization System Performance Report*. Based on the recommendation, the Alameda County Health Services Agency submitted the attached May 17, 2017 letter requesting a meeting to discuss the site. To remain in compliance with previous County requests, Trinity performed the 2017 SSVD system sampling event and presented the results in the June 30, 2017 *2017 Sub-Slab Vapor Depressurization System Performance Report*. Based the results of the 2017 system sampling, Trinity is rescinding the request for case closure evaluation until after the generally decreasing system effluent concentrations are below the appropriate screening levels. We request that the meeting also be postponed.
