Ladies and Gentlemen:

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) is considering the above referenced site for potential case closure. As you are aware, numerous site investigations and groundwater monitoring events for underground storage tank leaks have been performed at the subject property to which you are named as the primary or active responsible party. Thank you for submitting the List of Landowners Form.

Due to the residual contamination on site, the site would be closed to existing use with site management requirements that require further evaluation if the site is to be redeveloped in the future.

Public Participation

Public participation is a requirement for the case closure process. In order to notify potentially affected members of the public of the potential fuel leak case closure, ACDEH will distribute the *Notification of Potential Case Closure* to addresses in the immediate vicinity. The *Notification of Potential Case Closure* requests that landowners or residents submit any comments or questions to ACDEH regarding potential case closure. ACDEH will consider all comments from the public prior to potential case closure. ACDEH will provide you with written notification if any comments are received during the following Public Comment Period:

- **February 9, 2018** – Public Comment Period Begins
- **April 10, 2018** – Public Comment Period Ends

Monitoring Well Destruction and Waste Removal Activities

Because this site is under the oversight of the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board's (SFRWQCB) Site Cleanup Program (SCP) (Case Number 01S0055) this letter is intended to serve as notification that groundwater monitoring wells MW-1, MW-2, and MW-3 are to be retained for future use for the SFRWQCB case.
