She is attempting to determine status of sites. I relay that we are also attempting to determine status. There are several sites in Emeryville that have not progressed due to complexity of different actions by differing agencies and subsequent poor documentation, and these are included in that group. Deed restrictions were discussed for the two sites, for a townhome development, but it appears that the site never went residential as it is largely a parking lot and a CVS store. We are currently attempting to gather available information, reports, or other documents to determine what steps are required next. If we can close out without a subsurface investigation it would be great, but I expect that we might need some, hopefully limited, additional subsurface data. Right now there is very little data to support actions at the site.

She has already contacted legal team for the Longs Drug Store purchase, and has determined that there was a 1999 / 2000 Phase 1. She has only seen an executive summary, but will attempt to determine if the full report remains in their files; however, it may have been destroyed related to archiving.
