**RE: Report of Soil and Groundwater Analysis Collected at
5892 Christie Avenue, Emeryville, California**

Dear Mr. Roa:

The Alameda County Department of Environmental Health, Hazardous Materials Division has received and reviewed the report of soil and groundwater analysis prepared by Polymatrix Associates for the referenced site. Based on this report, soil samples collected from the three hydraulic hoists excavation showed no detectable levels of hydraulic fluid. The groundwater samples from two hoists areas also showed no detectable levels of hydraulic fluid. However, the groundwater sample collected from the hoists excavation identified as "South Lift GW" had 1.5 mg/l of hydraulic fluid.

Per our telephone conversation today, a confirmatory groundwater sample from the hoist excavation with 1.5 mg/l detectable levels of hydraulic fluid must be re-sampled and analyzed by a state certified lab. This additional sampling had been discussed with Mr. Frank Stern, owner of the property and Mr. Fred Davis of Polymatrix Associates.

It is also necessary that you submit to this office a deposit of \$536.00 made payable to the County of Alameda. This deposit is authorized under **Section 3-141.6 of the Ordinance Code of the County of Alameda** and is used to cover the expenses incurred by the County personnel in the execution of their oversight responsibilities associated with the project. Records of the time County employees commit to the project are maintained and the deposit is charged an hourly rate of \$67.00. Upon completion of the project, the balance of the deposit will be refunded to you.
