In order to comply with the RWQCB's 30-day review period, attached is the closure summary for the referenced site, located at 5885 Hollis Street, Emeryville, CA. If no comments from the RWQCB are received within the 30-day review period, ACEH's will proceed with case closure.

The site was redeveloped and a significant amount of soil was excavated to approximately 15 feet bgs across a majority of the site. It was a Unocal bulk oil terminal in a former life. Residual contamination will be left in place at the south end that appears to be largely attributable to the immediately adjacent 76 / Chevron service station, although contamination from former uses may also be present. The site will be placed in the Emeryville permit tracking system. No wells were installed.
